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E X T R A C T

1. The following Officers, Flight Officers and Enlisted Men, Combat Crews per attached lists are trfd and WP to AAB, Topeka, Kansas, at such time as will enable them to arrive thereat and report to C.O., 272nd AAF, Base Unit (SB), on or about noon 17 July 1944.

a. Travel of dependents and shipment of HH goods to points within the continental limits of the United States is authorized within the prov of Sec. VI, WD Cir 261, 1942.

b. The Gen Sup O will provide for the movement to Topeka, Kansas, for personnel ordered to that sta per this paragraph, the nec fld ranges, cooking & serving utensils & arrange for the ret of same to the TO this sta; provide the nec ice & cleaning supplies; provide troop train rations for six (6) meals increased by troop train rations for two (2) add meal (par 3 a (3)(a), WD Cir #341, 43). The Gen Sup O will make the proper installation of nec fld ranges in kitchen car or cars & provide the nec fuel. In accordance with par 3 b, WD Cir #341, 43, the FD will pay in advance to the Train Comdr, funds for the purchase of ice & in an emergency, articles of subs, a/r six cents (6¢) per ration (2¢ per meal) for the six (6) meals provided for the scheduled travel time, plus amounts at the same rate for the two (2) add meal provided for delays enroute. The Train Comdr is responsible for the immediate ret of fld ranges & cooking & serving utensils to proper sta. The Train Comdr will make accounting of his stewardship as required by WD Cir #341, 43.

d. Quarters for all single Officers are terminated at BOQ's off 15 July 1944.
